All our rides are marked with flags, arrows or tape, and you will get a full set of ride instructions including a map. The beauty of this sport is that you can set your own challenges, be that having a lovely weekend of relaxed fun riding in the countryside that you would perhaps not normally have access to or wether you want to have a go at the longer distances or some of our more challenging rides. Any kind of horse, and any kind of rider, (Para riders most welcome), can have a go at Endurance Riding.

North & East Yorkshire Group of Endurance are looking to host an evening about Endurance and how to understand and get the most out of the vetting process, the vetting process which takes place at an Endurance event that is running Competitive and Pleasure rides.

The talk will be given by one of Endurance GB regularly used Vets Catriona Moon. Catriona is a top Endurance rider with World champs experience as well as a full time vet.

Catriona would like to help the riders understand the vetting process used at an Endurance ride, how to trot up and how to get the best out of it and how it can help you understand your horse more.

This will be ideal for people wanting to know what happens at an event as well as those riders who enjoy hacking and wanting to try the next stage, plus those riders who have already attended rides but would like to get to know more.

Will also look at the vet sheet riders complete before the ride and what information is on there.
